ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that there is a need in the District of New Mexico for a temporary, emergency intracircuit assignment of a magistrate judge due to a conflict with all the judges in the District of New Mexico. Blackburn, who is the presiding judge in civil case number 16-CV-0761 REB, requested an out of district magistrate judge from the District of Colorado be assigned to this case.

Wang to serve temporarily as a magistrate judge in the District of New Mexico for the life of civil case number 16-CV-0761 REB. She is authorized to handle all pretrial, non-dispositive motions and any settlement conferences as needed in civil case number 16-CV-0761 REB.
