AMENDED SUPERSEDING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Assistant Federal Public Defenders and Assistant United States Attorneys who are duly hired by their respective offices for the District of New Mexico, who are admitted to the practice of law in a State other than New Mexico, in the District of Columbia or in any Territory of the United States, and who are admitted to practice law in this or any other Federal District Court, may practice law before all judges in this Court in the capacity for which they were hired, upon completion of the Application for Admission, SF-001, including the Oath contained therein, and submission of a Certificate of Good Standing from their licensing State or Territory or the District of Columbia.

This Order supersedes the prior Administrative Order of June 15, 2000 Misc. No. 95-150.
