
THE COURT, having approved the certification of the Bankruptcy Judges for the need of establishing a Clerk for the Bankruptcy Court for this District, hereby **ORDERS**,

That the Bankruptcy Clerk be, and his is, hereby designated as the accountable officer for all monies paid into and disbursed from the registry of the Bankruptcy Court in petitions and proceedings pending before or adjudicated by a Bankruptcy Judge in this District. The Bankruptcy Clerk shall receive all such funds for this Court and shall deposit them in the name of the U.S. District Court for the District of New Mexico (Bankruptcy) in accordance with 28 U.S.C. 2041, and shall withdraw such funds only in accordance with 28 U.S.C. 2042.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Bankruptcy Clerk shall collect all fees, costs and deposit fund monies in petitions and proceedings referred to the Bankruptcy Judges and shall be accountable for such funds. The Bankruptcy Clerk shall also be responsible for the supervision of all personnel handling bankruptcy monies, the establishment of control procedures, the maintenance of financial records, the collection and proper disposition of all fees, costs and other deposit fund monies.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that the Bankruptcy Clerk shall make appropriate reconciliation, accounting and periodic reports as required by the Administrative Office of the United States Courts.
