Applicants will have had demonstrated experience in cases of this nature.

#### **Auxiliary Panel**

Members of the Auxiliary Panel will handle such matters as misdemeanor offenses within federal jurisdiction and material witness representation.

#### **Appeal/Habeas Panel**
