Judge Yarbrough Dress Code

Notice: To all witnesses, jurors, agents and courtroom spectators.

- 1. To maintain the dignity of the Court, the Court requests that the following list of minimum standards regarding appropriate dress be met before entering the courtroom.
- 2. Men should wear a shirt with a collar and long pants. (Jeans are acceptable).
- 3. Women should wear a dress, or a blouse and skirt or long pants. (Jeans are acceptable).
- 4. All laypersons should wear shoes in the courtroom. (Thongs are not acceptable).
- 5. Shorts, T-shirts, and revealing clothing are not acceptable. (Anything that reveals the midriff or underclothing).
- 6. Hats or caps must be removed while in the courtroom.

Deviations from the above standards by lay persons (other than those who are in custody at the time of the proceeding) should be brought to the attention of court personnel and approved by the Court prior to entering the courtroom.
