

ORDER

Effective immediately, if a party in a criminal case files a motion for review, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3145, of an order entered by a United States Magistrate Judge sitting in Las Cruces to detain or release a defendant with conditions, any brief by the appellant shall be filed no later than 14 days from the date of the Magistrate Judge's order. Any responsive brief shall be filed no later than 14 days thereafter. Should the appellant opt not to file a brief, the appellant shall notify the District Court with original jurisdiction over the offense no later than 3 days from the date of the Magistrate Judge's order. A reply will not be entertained unless requested by the Court.
