**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, pursuant to Rule 59(a) of the FEDERAL RULES OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, a party may serve and file objections to any order within fourteen (14) days after being served a copy of a written order or after the oral order is stated on the record. Failure to file a timely objection waives a party's right to a review.
